¹ Child Abuse can be defined as an act, or failure to act, on the part of a parent and / or caregiver, including those that have access to a child, that results in the death, serious physical or emotional harm, sexual abuse, or exploitation of a child, or which places the child in an imminent risk of serious harm, and / or serious impacts the Child's long-term development and potential. Please also see Article 19 of the UNCRC.
